Virginia FCCLA State Fair contests include:

FCCLA Poster: A poster that promotes ANY FCCLA program or activity: judged on originality, creativity, and neatness. Posters must be created digitally and printed on an 8 ½" by 11" sheet of paper. Posters should have an entry form attached to the back and be put into a page protector.

Brand FCCLA Wear/Accessories: Any one item that can be used as an accessory to an outfit that promotes FCCLA: judged on originality, creativity, and neatness. "Going Green" is encouraged! Special consideration will be given to those accessories that are made of material that was recycled or reused.

Brand FCCLA Wear/Clothing: Any one item that can be worn that promotes FCCLA: judged on originality, creativity, and neatness. Clothing items must be brought on a hanger, in the event there is space to hang items for display. "Going Green" is encouraged! Special consideration will be given to those clothing items that are made of material that was recycled and reused.

Brand FCCLA at Home: Any one item that can be displayed or used at home that promotes FCCLA: judged on originality, creativity, and neatness. "Going Green" is encouraged! Special consideration will be given to those items that are made of material that was recycled and reused.

A completed entry form **MUST** be attached to each project. Current state officers will judge the entries. Each participant will receive a ribbon and the top winner in the 6-9th grade category and the 10-12th grade category will each receive a trophy. There is a \$1.00 entry fee for each project and only one project may be submitted per student.
