

Virginia FCCLA House Rules for the Business Session of the Annual State Leadership & Recognition Conference

Below are the standing rules that will be presented to the voting delegates during the Business Session. These rules will be voted on prior to conducting the business of the Virginia Association and will go into effect immediately if approved. These rules may be revised by the State Executive Council or Virginia FCCLA Board of Directors. Notification of any revision will be posted on the Bylaws page of the Virginia FCCLA website. The House Rules will be printed on the conference screens and reviewed orally prior to presentation to the voting delegates for approval.

The House Rules state:

- ◆ Voting Delegates must be seated in the reserved seating area.
- ◆ Only Voting Delegates may make, second and vote on motions.
- ◆ Only Voting Delegates may participate in discussion.
- ◆ Voting Delegates must come to the microphone and state their name and chapter before making or seconding a motion.
- ◆ Motion slips are available and must be completed for the minutes of the session.
- ◆ Voting will be conducted by show of hands.
- ◆ Delegates must be holding a delegate ribbon when voting.
- ◆ The session parliamentarian or the FCCLA state adviser, may be called upon to speak regarding parliamentary law or answer questions.
