**Virginia FCCLA State Fair contests include:**

FCCLA Poster: A poster that promotes **ANY** FCCLA program or activity: judged on originality, creativity, and neatness. Posters must be created digitally and or hand drawn and presented on an 8 ½” by 11” sheet of paper. Posters should have an entry form attached to the back and be put into a page protector.

Brand FCCLA Wear - Accessories: Any one item that can be used as an accessory to an outfit that promotes FCCLA: judged on originality, creativity, and neatness. “Going Green” is encouraged! Special consideration will be given to those accessories that are made of material that was recycled or reused.

Brand FCCLA Wear - Clothing: Any one item that can be worn that promotes FCCLA: judged on originality, creativity, and neatness. Clothing items must be brought on a hanger, in the event there is space to hang items for display. “Going Green” is encouraged! Special consideration will be given to those clothing items that are made of material that was recycled and reused.

Brand FCCLA at Home: Any one item that can be displayed or used at home that promotes FCCLA: judged on originality, creativity, and neatness. “Going Green” is encouraged! Special consideration will be given to those items that are made of material that was recycled and reused.

A completed entry form **MUST** be attached to each project. Members of the Virginia FCCLA State Executive Council will judge the entries. Each participant will receive a ribbon and the top winner in the three levels (Level 1 - grades 6-8, Level 2 - grades 9-10, and Level 3 - grades 11-12) will each receive a trophy. Honorable Mention certificates will also be awarded as seen appropriate by the state executive council. There is a \$2.00 entry fee for each project and only one project may be submitted per student.

### **TO PAY FOR TICKETS IN ADVANCE**

  - Be sure to click on the correct date and register - Thursday, October 1st
  - Tickets are \$8.00 per student
  - With eight student tickets, you will receive one adviser/adult ticket for free
  - Additional adult tickets are \$12.00
  - Ride wristbands are \$20.00 and can be purchased in advance separately.
  - This method requires a credit card payment and is non refundable
  - Once you finish this process, you will receive a confirmation email.

### **TO RESERVE TICKETS AND PAY AT THE GATE**

  - Be sure to click on the correct date and reserve - Thursday, October 1st
  - Tickets are \$8.00 per student
  - With eight student tickets, you will receive one adviser/adult ticket for free.
  - Additional adult tickets are \$12.00
  - Ride wristbands are \$20.00 and can be purchased in advance.
  - Chapters then pay at the gate with a credit card or check. Cash will not be accepted. You will be required to pay for the number of kids that you reserve tickets for.
  - Once you finish this process, you will receive a confirmation email.

Tickets on the day of your visit without registering or reserving:

- Students and adult tickets will be \$12.00
- Ride wristbands are \$20.00
